Ferndale Dance Protocols & Procedures for Covid-19

Updated 7/31/20

As we approach new phases these Protocols & Procedures may change.

Ferndale Dance will be doing all it can to create a healthy, clean and safe environment this fall.

Instructors will be wearing face coverings, screening for signs and symptoms & taking temperatures prior to teaching.

Studios, bathrooms, hallways and surfaces will be frequently cleaned and sanitized.

Students please wear a face covering when entering and exiting the building, wash or sanitize hands before and after class and stay home if at all sick. Please come dressed in appropriate dance clothes. Bathrooms will be available but dressing room will be unavailable for changing.

Families please wait outside when possible to allow for less traffic in the hallway. Masks required for all families entering building to drop off/pick up dancers.

Classes will be close to between 5-8 students depending which room they will be in. There will be more overlapping of class start and end times to allow less students & parents in hallways at a time and social distancing will be practiced when possible.

Performances are tentatively scheduled for December 4th & 5th at Ferndale High School Auditorium. A decision about whether we will have a winter performance or an alternative performance will be decided by the first week in October. If we cannot have a performance at all this winter then this Fall session will be focused on our students' technique in the different styles and starting in January we will begin working towards a Spring Performance. Please note our schedule usually changes between December & January when a new session starts.

Fees & Refunds. If students cannot attend classes due to Covid they will be credited or refunded for each missed class. There will be no make up classes at this time. Performance Fees will not be due until October 10th and will only be required this session if we have a winter performance.

Upon enrollment families will be required to sign a Student Waiver & Release of Liability Agreement before finishing registration. This must be signed to attend any classes.
